

Temple Judea Holds Food Drive on Yom Kippur

On the morning of Yom Kippur, the Jewish High Holy Day of repentance that includes fasting, congregants from Temple Judea of Manhasset brought bags of much needed groceries to morning services. A truck from the Interfaith Nutrition Network (the INN) was parked at the front of the synagogue to collect the food that congregants dropped off as they arrived. Later that day, the truck returned to collect food before children's services so that literally tons of canned goods and other non-perishable food items were donated to the INN's food pantries. This continued an annual tradition at Temple Judea.
