On Sunday, April 20th, for the first time in its history, families are invited when Temple Judea of Manhasset will be conducting a second night *Seder*, the dinner and service that commemorates the Passover holiday. To continue the temple's tradition of openness, it is inviting the public to attend this exciting event.

“While many people celebrate the first night of this important holiday with their family, they also may want a change for the second night,” said Tod Groman, President of Temple Judea. “We thought we’d offer something wonderful and open our doors to the entire community so that others could share this traditional holiday in a temple setting. Coupled with no need to cook, serve or clean up, what more could you want?”

Rabbi Todd Chizner will lead the family-oriented *Seder* to which people of all ages are invited. Reading of the *Haggadah* will include the telling of the story of the Jews exodus from Egypt and continue with the rituals that commemorate this holiday, which is an integral part of the Jewish religion.

The meal, catered by the temple's own Newman & Leventhal caterers, promises to be a delicious blend of traditional treats with the gourmet touch the caterer always brings to the table. In addition to food, there will be the traditional four cups of wine and the festivities that commemorate the holiday.

Those interested in attending should contact the temple immediately as space is limited. The cost for attendance is \$85 per adult and \$70 per child. RSVP's will not be taken after April 14.
