**PRESENTATION ON NATIONAL HEALTHCARE
AT TEMPLE JUDEA**

MANHASSET, NY – One of the major issues in this year’s election will be the healthcare crisis in the United States. The US spends over \$2 trillion a year on healthcare and ranks only 37th in healthcare performance according to the World Health Organization.

To learn more about this issue, Temple Judea’s Greatest Generation Committee will be holding a film presentation and lecture to review how healthcare operates in three countries. The event entitled “Medicare For All: The Time is Now!” is open to the community at large and will be held on Sunday, September 14 from 2:00 to 4:00 pm.

Aaron Beckerman, professor emeritus of Yeshiva University will lead the discussion with a film presentation and will then compare national healthcare programs in Great Britain, Japan and Germany.

Refreshments will be served following the event along with a question and answer period. A \$5 fee will be collected to cover programming costs.
